With effect from Sem 1 AY2022/2023, students applying for the Department Ethic Review Committee (DERC), please email your application directly to NUSC Ethics Review @ nusc.ethics@nus.edu.sg for approval.

All student research involving humans as research participants must be subject to ethics review by either the NUS Institutional Review Board (NUS-IRB) or the Department (DERC). Students are not required to apply for DERC review if their research is low-risk, involve non-vulnerable populations, and they have no intention to publish (even in future). If there are any risk to subjects, or vulnerable populations are involved, or the student might want to publish, DERC approval is required.
